Dear BSP Scientific Forest Management Area Advisory Committee Members:

I hope everyone is enjoying the start of fall weather over the last week or so. Our fall Advisory tour of the SFMA is fast approaching on the **September 27, 2013**. The attached schedule will give you a sense of how the day will be structured. We will devote the entire tour to the subject of the summer wind storm, the damage it caused, the salvage operation that is on-going, and the potential monitoring and research opportunities the event presents. We will start off the tour with a brief indoor overview of the areas impacted and the damage severity. The rest of the day will be in the field looking at the impact and response first hand.
